

FOR HOMESCHOOL FAMILIES WITH TEFA FUNDS

188 CURRICULUMS TAKE THE TEFA VOUCHER. HERE'S HOW TO PICK ONE IN AN AFTERNOON.

We checked every vendor site. Only 18 of the 188 teach every subject. 47 say "TEFA" on their own website, which means they've done this before. The options below fit each situation and show a price or a trial.

★ READ TO THE END →

Page 2 is *the afternoon that picks a curriculum*: two samples, a placement test, one trial order, *and the one reason an order from an approved vendor still gets rejected*.

IF YOU'RE LOOKING FOR...

ONE PROGRAM, EVERY SUBJECT, ON A LAPTOP

Your kid works mostly alone. Your TEFA funds pay for Alpha Omega Monarch (free trial, says TEFA on its site) Connected Learning (\$14.95 a month, free trial) or Harmony Online Learning. Try one for a week before you buy the year.

ONE PROGRAM, PRINTED BOOKS, YOU TEACH

You're the teacher, books on the table. Alpha Omega LIFEPAK Treehouse Schoolhouse (full-year kits) or The Curriculum Store (mix kits from several publishers in one cart). All three say TEFA on their sites.

LIVE TEACHERS ON A SCHEDULE

A real person teaching at a set time. Blue Manor Academy (\$29.99 to \$199.99 a month, try it first). On the state's list; ask before you order.

CHARLOTTE MASON OR CLASSICAL

Heart of Dakota (Charlotte Mason, samples online) or Veritas Press (classical, \$579 a course). Both on the list.

THE LEAST SPENT ON CURRICULUM

The rest of the \$2,000 goes to a tutor. Connected Learning is \$129 a year for every subject; Educate Your Way is \$19.99 a month with a 7-day trial.

These are the ones that fit each situation and already show a price or a trial. They are not the only ones: all 188 are in the online table. "Says TEFA on its site" is the best sign a vendor has handled a TEFA order before.

FOUR CHECKS THAT TAKE AN AFTERNOON, NOT A SEMESTER

1 Does it cover every subject, or just one?
The vendor's own site says. Most of the 188 sell one subject.

2 Who does the teaching?
Live teacher, recorded lessons, or you. Be honest about your hours.

3 Is there a placement test?
Skip the grade-level guess.

4 Can you try it first?
A free trial or a sample week beats a screenshot.

Before you pay:

"Is this exact product approved for TEFA?" Being a listed vendor and selling an approved item are two different things. Ask, then order through the marketplace.

THE AFTERNOON THAT PICKS A CURRICULUM

Three hours, one trial order, a two-week test. Then you buy the year.

HOURL ONE: PULL TWO SAMPLES

From your row on page 1, open two. Every one below shows a price and a way to try; "says TEFA" means the vendor names it on its own site.

If you want	Try these two
Every subject, online, on their own	Alpha Omega Monarch (free trial; says TEFA) · Connected Learning (\$14.95 a month; free trial; says TEFA)
Every subject, printed, you teach	Treehouse Schoolhouse (full-year kits; says TEFA) · The Curriculum Store (kits from several publishers; says TEFA)
Live teachers on a schedule	Blue Manor Academy (\$30 to \$200 a month; try first) · ask any of the 18 whether it runs live classes
Charlotte Mason or classical	Heart of Dakota (samples) · Veritas Press (\$579 a course; samples)
The least spent, so the rest goes to a tutor	Connected Learning (\$129 a year) · Educate Your Way (\$19.99 a month; 7-day trial)

HOURL TWO: THE PLACEMENT TEST

- 1 Most of the 18 have one.**
Take it before you pick a grade; the grade on the box is a guess.
- 2 If there isn't one,**
do the first lesson of the grade you think, then the one below. Pick the level your kid gets mostly without you.

HOURL THREE: ORDER THE TRIAL THROUGH THE MARKETPLACE

- 1 In Odyssey, search the vendor's exact name,**
open the listing for the trial or the smallest unit (a month, one subject).
- 2 Order that, not the year.**
The vendor confirms; the order shows in your history.

The two-week test:

did your kid open it without being asked? Did you know what to do when they got stuck? Two yeses, buy the year. One no, try the other sample.

If the order is rejected:

the state approves vendors; Odyssey approves items. The finder's own words: listed vendors "still need specific offerings approved for the Odyssey Marketplace." Ask "is this exact product approved for TEFA?" then order the one they confirm.
