

FOR HOMESCHOOL FAMILIES WITH TEFA FUNDS

YOU CAN PAY FOR A CHRISTIAN CURRICULUM WITH YOUR TEFA VOUCHER. HERE ARE ALL 48, SORTED.

48 vendors on the state's curriculum list describe themselves as faith-based. The list doesn't say what tradition, what they teach, or what they cost, so we read every site. 27 say Christian, 4 Catholic, 2 Reformed, 16 don't say a tradition. Only 10 teach every subject.

★ READ TO THE END →

Page 2 is *the afternoon that picks a Christian curriculum*, and it ends with *the mistake in this category that costs families the most*, and the two-word check that prevents it.

IF YOU'RE LOOKING FOR...

EVERY SUBJECT, CHRISTIAN, ONE PUBLISHER

You want one Christian program that covers everything.
Alpha Omega (\$110 to \$440 a year, free trial, says TEFA on its site)
Heart of Dakota (\$331 a year, samples online)
My Father's World (\$265 to \$651)
Sonlight (\$984 to \$1,308, samples)
HeroesMart (says TEFA, price on request).

EVERY SUBJECT, CATHOLIC

You want a Catholic program for the whole day.
Catholic Heritage Curricula (\$108 to \$378 a year, preschool to 8, samples online).
Subject by subject: Seton (about \$18 a subject, samples) or Catholic Textbook Project.

REFORMED

Living Heritage Homeschool (\$99 to \$419 a course, K to 12, samples) for the full day;
Little Pilgrims Theology (\$120 a year) for catechism.

A LIVE TEACHER

You want classes at a set time with a real person.
Blue Manor Academy (\$30 to \$200 a month, PreK to 12, try it first).

Not the only ones: all 48 are in the online table. Prices as shown on vendor sites Sept 16 to 17, 2026.

1 Does it cover every subject, or one?

Column three on the next page.

2 Which tradition, in their own words?

Sixteen of the 48 don't say. Ask.

3 Who teaches?

Most are parent-led; Blue Manor has live classes.

Before you pay:

"Is this exact product approved for TEFA?" The state approved the vendor. The marketplace approves items. Ask in writing, then order through Odyssey.

THE AFTERNOON THAT PICKS A CHRISTIAN CURRICULUM

Two samples, one check, one trial order. Then you buy the year.

HOURL ONE: TWO SAMPLES FROM YOUR TRADITION

If you want	Try these
Every subject, Christian, one publisher	Alpha Omega (\$110 to \$440 a year; free trial; says TEFA) · Heart of Dakota (about \$331 a year; samples) · My Father's World (\$265 to \$651 a year)
Every subject, Catholic	Catholic Heritage Curricula (\$108 to \$378 a year; samples) · Seton, subject by subject (about \$18 each; samples)
Reformed or classical	Living Heritage Homeschool (\$99 to \$419 a course; samples) · Veritas Press (\$579 a course; samples)
Live classes, Christian	Blue Manor Academy (\$30 to \$200 a month; try first)
One subject to add on	Notgrass (history) · Apologia (science) · Biblioplan (history and Bible); good add-ons, not a full day

HOURL TWO: THE TWO-WORD CHECK

- 1 Every subject?**
The vendor's own site says. If it lists "Bible" or "history" and nothing else, it's one subject, and your kid still needs math, reading, and science from somewhere.
- 2 Which grade?**
Take the placement test if there is one; the grade on the box is a guess.

HOURL THREE: ORDER THE TRIAL THROUGH THE MARKETPLACE

- 1 In Odyssey, search the vendor's exact name**
and open the smallest listing (a month, a sample pack, one subject).
- 2 Order that, not the year.**
Two weeks later: did your kid open it without being asked? Then buy the year.

The mistake that costs the most here:

buying a one-subject program as the whole year. A Bible course is not a curriculum. 12 of the 48 teach one subject; the \$2,000 spent there leaves nothing for math and reading. Two words before you order: every subject? If the site doesn't say it, it isn't.
